

## **Volunteering Opportunities**

**Pantry Volunteering**: Volunteers help clients shop the pantry, stock shelves, and intake donations. We can have a maximum of 6 volunteers at a time in the pantry. Groups with more people than that will break into two or more shifts so that everyone can help in the pantry. No special skills required. Open hours listed below, volunteers are able to choose their shift within that range.

**Monday Night Meal**: Volunteers cook and serve a community meal together for around 60 individuals. The kitchen comfortably accommodates groups of 5-10 volunteers. Meals can be prepared in the kitchen or at home and dropped off.
